Thank you for all your patience during the build of our latest extension. We are so pleased to announce that it is complete and ready for another busy summer ahead (whatever gets us through the winter, right?) We now have 47 additional 20m berths and four more 40m berths.

Fuel pumps are operational, offering high and low flow diesel, as well as unleaded. We are excited to be able to offer this service, and have worked to keep the pump price as low as possible (currently \$1.70/lit diesel, \$1.75/lit unleaded). The two bowsers are located on the land side of the first marina arm, as you enter the bay from the river.

Also up and running on the same arm is a sparkling new pump-out facility, available 24/7. There are operating instructions on the unit. If you need alternative attachments there are a few available from the office. Just call us if you have any questions about how to use it. The general public are welcome to use this facility so feel free to let your mates know.
